Austin Convention Q & A's

Where and when can I pick up my badge and onsite program? STAFDA's registration partner, ExpoTracker, will be emailing badge confirmations *prior* to the Austin Convention. They'll do two rounds of emails: The first was October 27 and the second will be **November 3**. Email addresses provided to STAFDA are to whom the badges will be sent. If someone from a company is serving as the point person for all registrations and provided STAFDA with only their email address, they will receive all badge notices for registered attendees. It will be up to them to forward the badge confirmations to attendees. Please be sure to check spam folders as sometimes confirmations get routed there!

Attendees will use the bar-coded confirmations to retrieve and print badges onsite. Please bring the email confirmation or a printout of the confirmation to the STAFDA Registration Desk for a "hard copy" of the badge along with picking up STAFDA's Convention Program & Addendum listing program details and all attendees.
